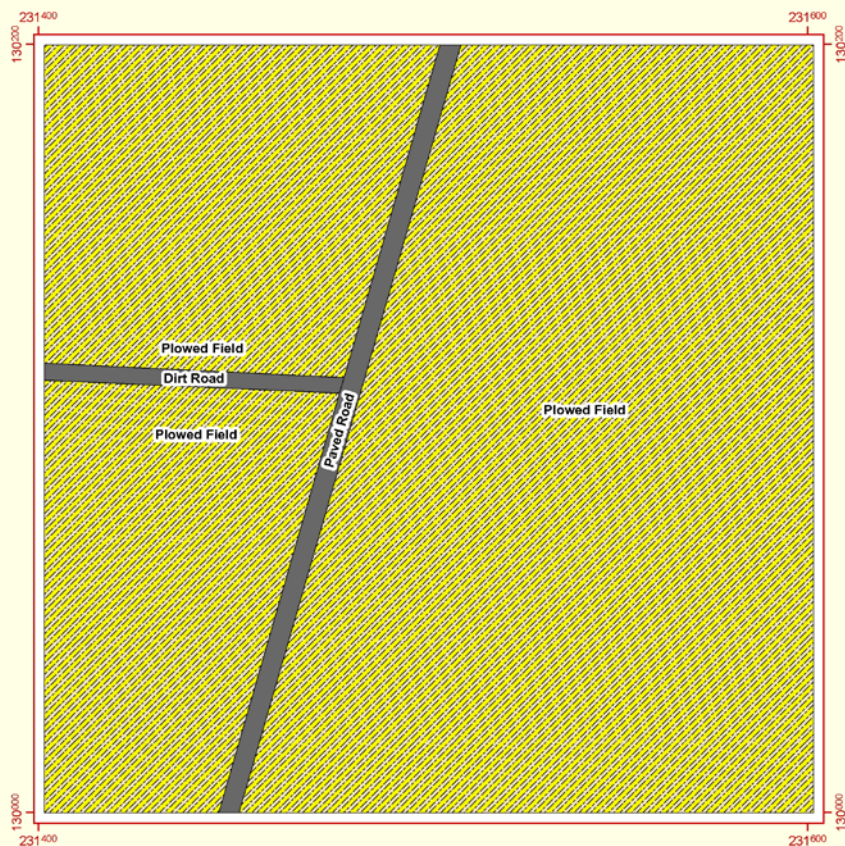

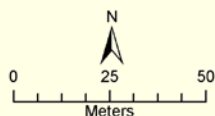
Tall Jalul Regional Survey -- Random Square 1



This square was located in an area of recently harvested grain at the northern reaches of the survey area. Herds of sheep and goats were feeding on the stubble when we visited. A blacktop road cut through the square from the north toward the southwest. A small 1.5m deep hole had been dug at the extreme northern edge of the square, perhaps to test the soil for future building activities.
